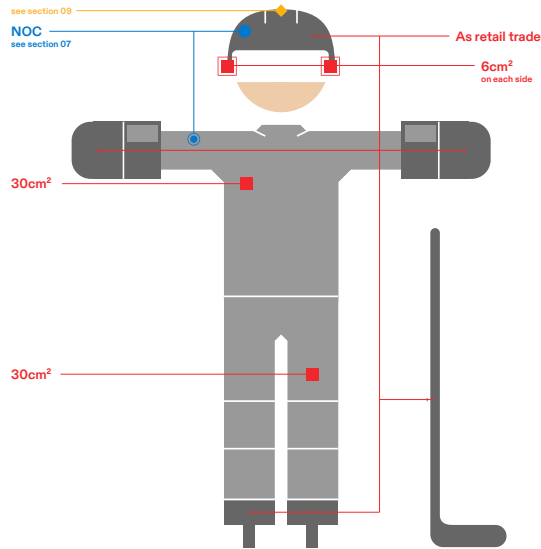
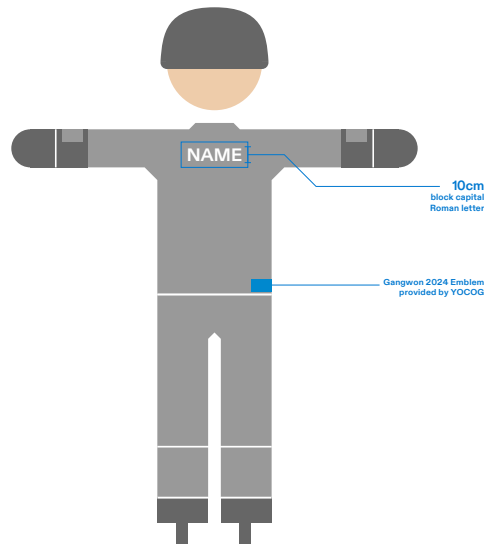

All General Principles apply unless expressly mentioned otherwise hereafter (in particular in relation to size, frequency or location). Please refer to the "Identifications on NOC Team Apparel Practical Guidelines", and General Guidelines (released Summer 2023) to obtain the general principles of Authorised Identifications on NOC uniforms at the Olympic Games. This section provides visual illustrations regarding the placement and size of Sport Specific Implementation for any items.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

Section 14 of General Guidelines apply

All goalkeeper masks and helmet designs are to be submitted to the IIHF and the IOC for review prior to the Winter Youth Olympic.

01 PLAYER FRONT

Identification of the Manufacturer

- **Jersey | Warm-up Jersey**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm^2 .
- **Pants**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm^2 .
- **Collars and roll necks**
If a roll neck or polo shirt is worn, no *Identification of the Manufacturer* may appear on the collar or on the neck.
Only one *Identification of the Manufacturer* will be allowed; it may be situated on the chest, with a maximum size of 30cm^2 .
- **Hockey socks | Socks tape**
No *Identification of the Manufacturer* may appear on these items.

Sports Equipment

- **Helmet | Head protector (full face mask)**
May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.
- **Facial protection**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per item will be permitted on each side, with a maximum size of 6cm^2 on player facial protection
- **Neck protection**
May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

- **Gloves**
May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.
- **Hockey stick**
May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

Accessories

- **Bags**
May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.
- **Towel**
No *Identification of the Manufacturer* may appear on these items.
- **Skates**
All footwear items may carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

Product Technology Identification

- **Jersey | Warm-up Jersey**
One additional *Product Technology Identification* will be permitted per clothing item, to a maximum size of 10cm^2 .
- **Pants**
One additional *Product Technology Identification* will be permitted per clothing item, to a maximum size of 10cm^2 .

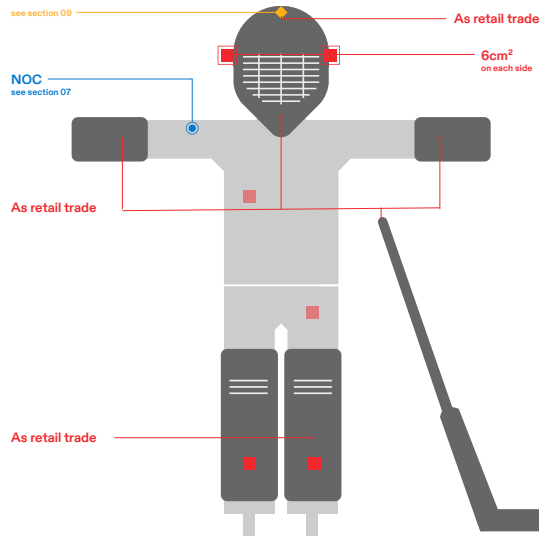

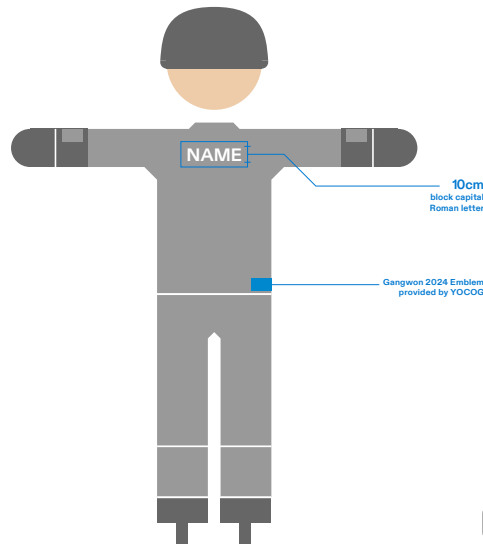

03 GOAL KEEPER FRONT

Identification of the Manufacturer

- Helmet | Head protector (full face mask)**
 May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.
- Facial protection**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item will be permitted on each side, with a maximum size of 6cm² on player facial protection.
- Neck protection**
 May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.
- Hockey stick | Leg pads | Blocker and trapper**
 May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

Accessories

- Bags**
 May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.
- Towel**
 No *Identification of the Manufacturer* may appear on these items.
- Skates**
 All footwear items may carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.
